TEACHING ACTIVITIES

Since I was the first Gastroenterology Fellow trained by Dr. Henry Janowitz when that program was established in 1954 and subsequently continued to the present time, and since I have continued in this Division of the Department of Medicine from that time to the present in a teaching capacity, I have been involved in the training of every graduate of this program from 1958 to the present time. In addition, I have been involved in the training of many medical students and residents rotating through the GI Division as well as those participating in preceptorships or research projects with me throughout this five decade time period.

My teaching responsibilities within the Gastrointestinal Division of the Department of Medicine throughout the entire existence of this division have included: Ward rounds with bedside teaching, consultations, endoscopy supervision and teaching fellows from the inception of that technique until eight years ago, 18 years of service on GI bleeding team, supervision and teaching in GI clinic, periodically conducting GI grand rounds and various seminars as well as participating in conferences, grand rounds and teaching courses in other departments (Surgery, Dermatology, Neurology, Hematology, Oncology, Pediatrics, Endocrinology and Medicine). For three years, I participated in the formal training curriculum for the Hematology/Oncology Fellows and as a recognized expert in one aspect of that subspecialty (neuroendocrine tumors) even though I am not a certified oncologist, I have been elected to membership in the American Society of Clinical Oncology.
