Since my wife's initial Carcinoid diagnosis in 2009, she had no treatment and negative scans for four years. But she went from negative to terminal within two months of her symptoms returning.

I was told Jackie had only weeks to live. I felt helpless, hopeless and powerless as I watched her suffer and in pain. I hope no one has to experience this and I hope for a day when no one will. With the advent of modern day technology, ordinary people just like you and I, have the POWER to effect change.
