

A Free Educational Workshop for Patients and Loved Ones Interested in Learning about Neuroendocrine & Carcinoid Tumors

This workshop will raise awareness among patients and caregivers about diagnoses, treatment options, managing side effects, coping with the psychosocial impact of neuroendocrine and carcinoid tumors, and fostering constructive dialogue with their health care team.

Featured speakers include:

- **Bonnie Bennett, RN BSN:** As Nurse Coordinator for the Neuroendocrine Tumor Treatment Program at the University of Pennsylvania, since its inception in September 2010, Bonnie has provided vital support for the program and cared for patients with gastroenteropancreatic neuroendocrine tumors (GEP-NETs) and pheochromocytomas / paragangliomas (PCC/PGL). The center has established itself as a unified program for both of these neuroendocrine tumor subtypes, which makes the program unique in the country. Bonnie has served on a variety of NET Nursing Advisory Boards and presented podium presentations for the Oncology Nursing Society (ONS) Annual Congress and the North American Neuroendocrine Tumor Society (NANETS) on Pheochromocytomas and Paragangliomas. She has served on the Allied Health program and planning committee for the NANETS Annual Symposium for the last two years. She facilitates bi-weekly, multidisciplinary Neuroendocrine Tumor Board meetings at Penn and collaborates with the NET faculty on a variety of research projects and protocols. She has been with the University of Pennsylvania Health System for over twenty years with nursing experience in a variety of settings other than neuroendocrine, including nephrology, dialysis, research and outpatient clinics.
- **Diann Boyd, BSN RN OCN:** As a Nurse Navigator for the Neuroendocrine Tumor Treatment Program at the University of Pennsylvania, Diann focuses on GI Oncology including neuroendocrine, colorectal, anal, gallbladder, esophageal, cholangiocarcinoma, gastric/stomach cancers.
